Guidelines for Childcare and Youth Program Participants

Please keep this form with you throughout the Convention for information and reference.

1. A wristband will be provided for each child at time of registration. This wristband must be worn at **ALL** times. A second wristband of a distinctive color will be required for any child with special allergies, needs, or instructions, specifying the instruction (e.g. "peanut allergy"). Replacement wristbands are available at the childcare check-in tables.
2. Parents or guardians must deliver and pick up their own children at the assigned times from the designated check in/check out location. All children will be checked in and out by name each day.
3. All children and teens will be supervised by a chaperone at all times with NO exceptions.
4. If any problems arise with your child/teen, you will be notified by posting of your name on a screen in the main lecture hall. Please review this screen periodically and move quickly to the area designated.
5. Modest dress is required for all those participating in the childcare and youth activities. This excludes any bare backs, shoulders, tummies, or thighs. No sleeveless tops. ALL clothes must be loose fitting. Skirts, dresses, and shorts must be of a modest length (to the knee).
6. A detailed schedule of all childcare activities and locations will be provided to each parent at the time of registration.
7. Parents are expected to administer any needed medication to their children during the convention.
8. Parents of childcare participants that have not yet been potty trained are expected to change their child's diapers or training pants during the program.
9. Program participants will be served snacks including such items as cookies, cheese and crackers, peanuts, fruit, and juice unless otherwise instructed on a second wristband.
